### An explanation by Brains

This year, a lot of Atari owners, or their parents, have bought Atari VCS cartridges while they were in the United States. When you get back, you find the cartridges don't work over here. Sorry, but it's not our fault!!

The American TV transmission system -NTSC / is quite different from the British TV transmission system - PAL. There is no way we can make NTSC cartridges work on PAL - so the shop in America misled you. By law, your best solution is to write to them, and ask them to return your money.

However, if this proves too difficult, we at Ingersoll Electronics are prepared to allow you £2.50 for your U.S. NTSC cartridge, against the price of a new PAL one, which will work in the U.K.
