"I enjoyed every second of it," said the youngest of our finalists at the National Finals of the Player of the Year Competition. And no wonder, it was a glittering occasion from start to finish.

The top 49 Atarians in the UK came down to London on Friday 19 August to try their skill against the slithery Centipede to become the UK Atari Player of the Year and win a trip to Munich to compete against Atarians all over the world and maybe even become the World Champion.

The Competition was held on the Saturday at London's hottest disco - the Camden Palace - and started with a breathtaking light show. As Centipede's theme music died down the compere, BBC TV personality, Keith

Chegwin, took the stage and the contest began. Cheggers kept everyone amused all afternoon and had a cheery word to say for both winners and losers alike. Other entertainment was provided by the fantastic duo, Tik and Tok, who did an amazing robotic mime and sang their latest single. Quite a number of the contestants had a go at robotic mime later in the evening . . . with some amazing results!

There was an hilarious Centipede celebrity challenge between David van Day, Tik, Tok and Cheggers, compered by our regional finals compere, Capital Radio DJ Richard Allinson - it's a good job that the real contestants didn't cheat as badly as our stars! And of course Ms Pac-Man came followed closely by Speedy, the ghost, and handed out lots of Atari goodies.

And the competition itself - well, that was pretty good fun too, and very exciting. Everyone really did very well, but our eventual winners were Stuart Murray, from Aberdeen with 221,983 points in the under-18 section

and Andrew Brzezinski from Greenford Middlesex with 197,710 points in the over-18 section. They both won Atari 800 computers and trips to Munich to the International Finals.

NATIONAL INTERNATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

After all the photographs and interviews with press and radio, Stuart, Andrew and all the other finalists went back to the Holiday Inn for a quick rest and then out again for an enjoyable evening trip down the Thames to celebrate everyone's success. The weekend was rounded off with a trip to the famous Regent's Park Zoo.

Out of over 80,000 contestants overall, the 49 contestants who came down to London did really well. Congratulations to you all - and see you next year!!!

But the fame and glory didn't stop in Munich - when Stuart and Andrew arrived back at Heathrow, a bevy of Fleet Street photographers was there to meet them, and Stuart was immediately whisked away to do a live radio interview from the recording suite at the airport. No pop star could hope for more!

And their scores: Stuart, 323,512 and Andrew, 322,044.

So congratulations to Stuart Murray and Andrew Brzezinski - the Atari World Champions.
