Here at last! DAVID CRANE, SUPERSTAR Meet a top video game designer.

We in the UK were the very first country outside the United States to meet David Crane, one of Activision's most successful designers. We had him over for two days, and for two days we never stopped! David, one of the world's top designers, is such a celebrity that everyone wanted to interview him - newspapers, TV, radio, and of course the top teen and video games magazines. He kept everyone enthralled with the story of his rise to fame - and got everyone playing Pitfall and Decathlon, which he just happened to have brought along! For the record, David's only 29 now - and he was lucky, he learned three computer languages while still at school! He evolved his first electronic game at 14, and this Mr Big (he's 6ft 6ins tall!) has designed many of Activision's other top selling games as well as Pitfall - such as Fishing Derby, Dragster and Laser Blast. David spent an afternoon with our Activision Games Champs - John Barber and Andrew Davis. They asked him loads of questions: they found out it takes between 6 months and a year (or 500/1,000 working hours) to develop a cartridge, and that David receives thousands of fan letters a week he has a battery of secretaries to do all the replies!

A word or two of advice from David to any of you who think you could make it as a video game designer:



"You must experiment with as many games, and as many systems, as possible. But more importantly, if you are to gain respect for your talents, you must undertake formal training. This means studying things like Engineering, Mathematics and Computer Science. And this is the type of job where you must be self-motivated, because no-one can get behind you to crack the whip! If you don't come up with the goods - enthralling, playable games - you're finished."

HOW TO TAKE A PHOTOGRAPH OF YOUR ON-SCREEN HIGH SCORE

It's easier than you'd think! Just follow these easy instructions:

DO NOT USE A FLASH BULB! In most cases the light from your screen is enough. When in doubt, turn on all the lights in the room. Remember, we're not looking for photographic works of art – merely proof of the score you've achieved. Providing that shows up clearly, it's all we need.

On-screen pics with 35mm cameras

D.A. Gunn of Burton Latimer got a good result on Kaboom!, and shot his pic with his 35mm camera set as follows (400 ASA film). Aperture set at 2.8, camera set on auto, about 125 shutter speed (on manual). Hope this helps 35mm camera owners.

35mm Camera: there are two methods we've tried with some success – but let us know if you discover another:

- Use film with an ASA reading of 64, set lens on f22 and expose film for 3 to 5 seconds. Use a tripod.
- For 100 ASA film shoot at 1/30 of a second using the widest lens opening. Hold steady!

Instamatic Cameras – 126 and 110: Insert a dead flashbulb or flashbar as this ensures the camera lens opening as wide as possible. Hold steady!

Polaroid – probably the most popular method. Polaroid film has an ASA of 3000 and so light from the TV screen should be sufficient. Hold steady!
