### HERE'S H.E.R.O.!

Are you tough enough to join an emergency rescue squad? The exciting new game H.E.R.O. from Activision will test your skills and perseverance to see if you measure up.

Roderick Hero leads the Helicopter Emergency Rescue Operation (H.E.R.O.) in a massive search, deep in the base of Mount Leone. A volcano has erupted, covering its deeply embedded mineshafts with rivers of molten lava, trapping large numbers of miners below the earth's surface.

Many of the miners are sealed off by rockslides, scattered over great distances – and a great deal of thought and precision planning must be used to get them to safety. Whilst blowing up the small walls blocking your path and finding your way through the maze of mines, you must avoid nesting snakes, shaft bats, springing spiders and mine moths – all of these could mean big trouble!

HOW TO TAKE A PHOTOGRAPH OF YOUR ON-SCREEN HIGH SCORE

It's not difficult! Just follow these easy instructions:

DO NOT USE A FLASH BULB! In most cases the light from your screen is enough. When in doubt, turn on all the lights in the room. Remember, we're not looking for photographic works of art – merely proof of the score you've achieved. Providing that shows up clearly, it's all we need.

35mm Camera: there are two methods we've tried with some success – but let us know if you discover another:

- Use film with an ASA reading of 64, set lens on f22 and expose film for 3 to 5 seconds. Use a tripod.
- 2. For 100 ASA film shoot at 1/30 of a second using the widest lens opening. Hold steady!
- For 400 ASA, Fun Club Member, D.A. Gunn recommends you set your aperture at 2.8, camera set on auto, about 125 shutter speed (on manual).

Instamatic Cameras – 126 and 110: Insert a dead flashbulb or flashbar as this ensures the camera lens opening as wide as possible. Hold steady!

Polaroid – probably the most popular method. Polaroid film has an ASA of 3000 and so light from the TV screen should be sufficient. Hold steady!
